Parents Code of Conduct

1. Make participation for your child and others a positive experience.
2. Have respect for your child's coach and for the officials.
3. Parents should be supporters. Allow the Coach to coach, the referee to officiate, and most all allow your child to play the game.
4. While supporting your child, applaud good play by your team AND by members of the opposing team.
5. The referee is a symbol of fair play, integrity and sportsmanship. DO NOT openly question their judgment.
6. Always accept the results of each game and encourage your child to be gracious in victory and turn defeat into victory by working towards improvement.
7. Remember that a child is easily affected by outside influences. If you disagree with an official (Coach or Referee) speak to them away from the children calmly without causing offence or upset.
8. The coach is a volunteer, giving personal time and effort to provide a recreational activity for your child. The coach is providing a valuable community service, often without reward. Without them your child could not participate.
